No fee is charged for the initial interview, where basic information will be gathered to determine whether the Legal Clinic can and will provide legal services. If we determine that we can help you, we will ask questions about your income to determine how much you will need to pay.

Households with income below 100% of the poverty level will not be required to pay fees to the Legal Clinic. Households with income levels above 250% of the poverty level may be referred to private attorneys.

If you would like to donate money to the Legal Clinic, you may do so at any time.
